Warren Keim Hall passed away from cancer on September 26, 2015 at his home in Larkspur, CO. surrounded by his family and friends. Warren is preceded in death by his mother Elizabeth, father Edward, & nephew Aaron. He is survived by his wife, Barbara of Larkspur, daughter Meredith (Justin) of Omaha, NE, son Drew (Janet) of Saudi Arabia, granddaughters Jackie & Sarah, grandsons Warren, Austin, & Kyle, sister Eleanor (Mike), brothers Bruce & Edward, nieces Lisa (Brian), Nicole (Phil), & Terry, nephews Rob (Jen), Phil, & Jim (Tricia), grandnephews & a grandniece.

Warren was born November 22, 1948 in Tampa, Florida. He graduated from Los Alamos High School in Los Alamos, NM in 1966 at which time he enrolled at Baylor University. Shortly thereafter he transferred to the University of New Mexico. In 1967 he was drafted into the U.S. Army – he served one tour of duty in Vietnam. Upon his return home he returned to school and enrolled at Eastern New Mexico University. During his time at ENMU he met his wife Barbara. He graduated from ENMU in 1974 and wed Barbara in August of 1975. From this marriage two kids were born, Drew in 1978 and Meredith in 1980. Barbara and Warren celebrated their 40th wedding anniversary this past August. Warren was a longtime resident of Durango, Colorado where he served his community through social work and community assistance. He spent his career giving back to mankind by servicing the people of Durango whom many people forgot about or turned their backs on – the homeless, the poor, mentally ill, developmentally disabled, and adult schizophrenics. In 2010, he and his wife Barb retired & moved to Larkspur to be closer to their son and granddaughters. They enjoyed the last few years traveling around the United States in their “Minnie Winnie” seeing the sights and relishing in their love for each other and their life. Anyone that knew Warren knew that he was an avid fly fisherman and guitar player. Most of all Warren enjoyed time spent with his kids and grandkids. He always said his greatest accomplishments were his kids - Meredith & Drew.
